Help Mary find her way to Jesus tomb.

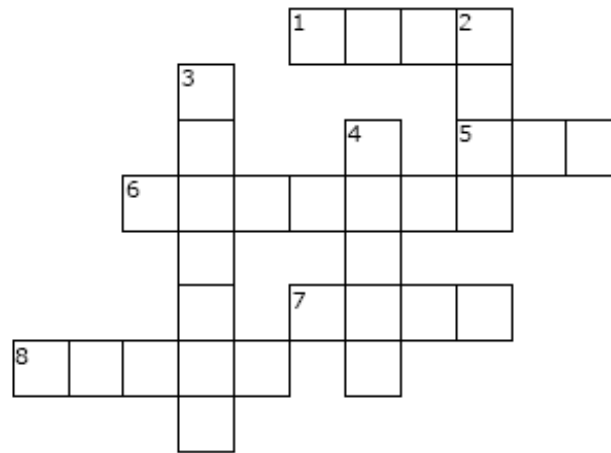


Easter Sunrise Surprise
