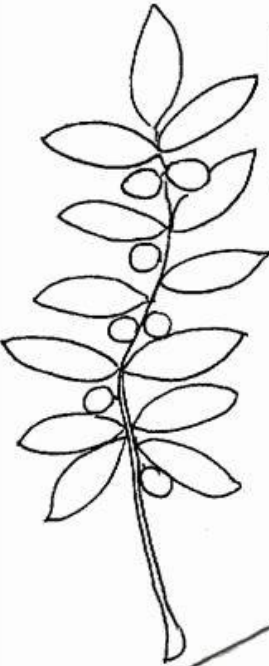

Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

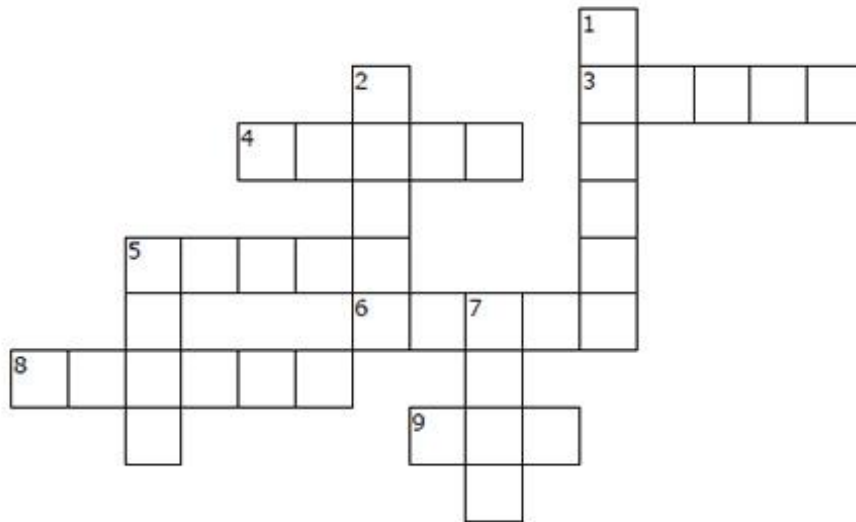
