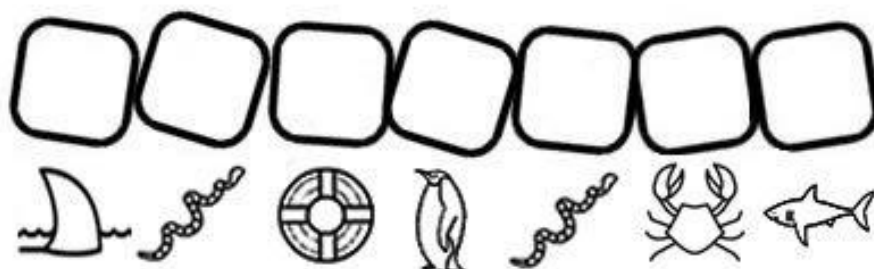
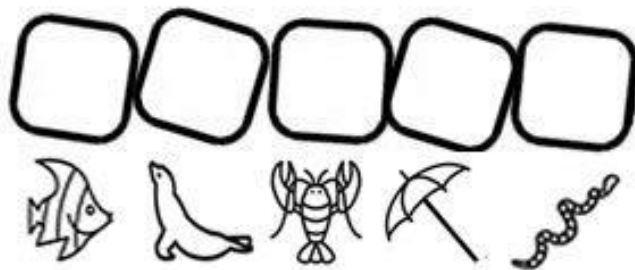
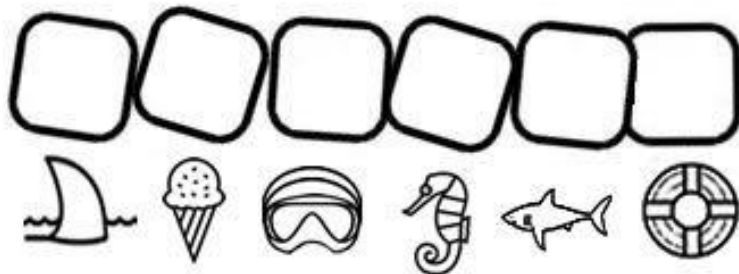

Being an Ally!

An ally is someone who stands up for people who are being treated unkindly or unfairly. People might get treated this way for reasons such as their skin color, religion, ability, or gender. Being an ally means providing support and doing your part to make sure things are fair and equal for all. Here are steps that you can take to be an ally!



Listen and Learn!

To be an ally, you need to listen to people when they share about their experiences. There are situations that they may go through in life that you've probably never had to think about. Instead of believing that their story is the same as yours, take time to listen and learn. You can ask to learn more, if they are willing to share, or you can look things up on your own.

Check Your Words and Actions!

Do you make jokes about certain groups of people or use words that might be unkind? How do you treat people who are different than you? If you're going to be an ally, make sure that you're not part of the problem! Start changing your behaviors and be careful of the words that you use.



Speak Up!

Speak up when you see unfair behavior or hear unkind words! You may see this in your family, with your friends, at your school, or in the community. Even if *you* aren't the one saying mean things, laughing along or not speaking up means that you are supporting that behavior. If you see someone getting treated unfairly, say or do something about it. Your voice and actions can make a huge difference!



Get Involved!

There are plenty of ways to get involved in making sure others get treated equally! There are groups you can join and events that you can participate in to provide your support to people who need it. Talk to a parent/guardian, teacher, or trusted adult and let them know that you're interested in being an ally!
