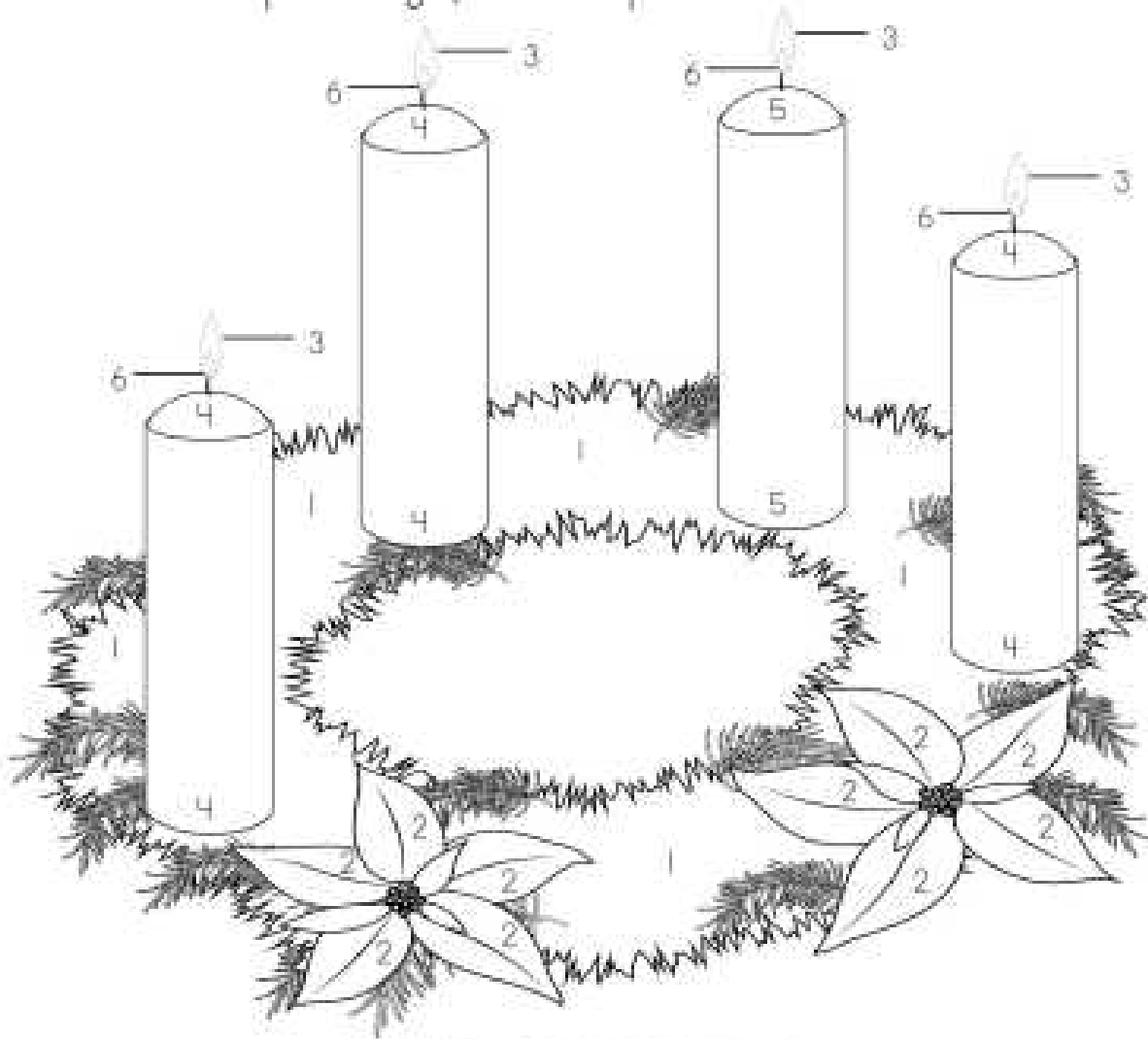


The Advent Wreath

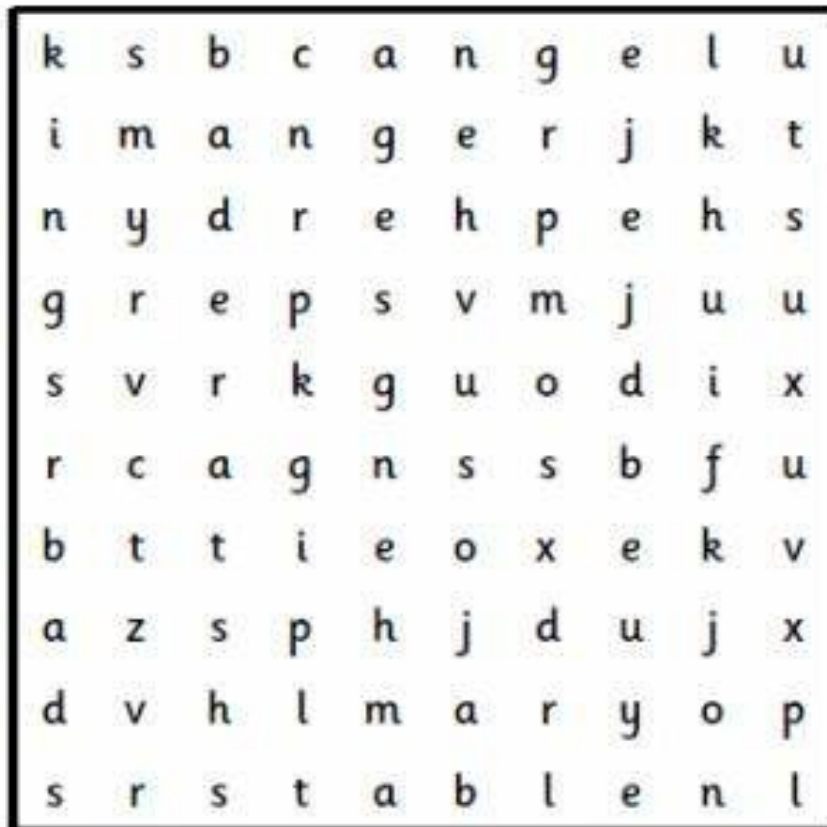
